In collaboration with like-minded people who contributed generously we were able to distribute that could suffice them for a month.

No matter whether rain or sun, nothing should dampen our spirit from helping the

victims of COVID. It's the need of the hour to look after our less fortunate brethren because reaching out to others and being at their service, requires courage and love for poor and needy, God wants us to be good visitors to them, to bring to them His love, Let us listen to our blessed Mother's invite and try to imitate her in word and deed.

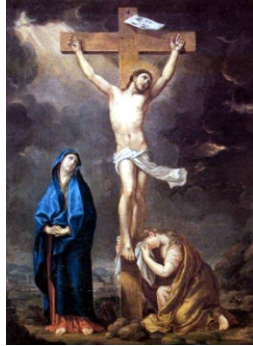
“She, who is the mother of sorrows and also the mother of consolation, can understand you completely and help you.” St. John Paul II

# LEGIONARIES REPORT

The Legion of Mary is a lay apostolic association of Catholics who, with the sanction of the Church and under the powerful leadership of Mary Immaculate, Mediatrix of all Graces, serves the Church on a voluntary basis.

Founder of the Legion of Mary, Frank Duff born in Dublin, Ireland, on June 7, 1889 formed the first presidium of the Legion of Mary on September 7, 1921. From that date until his death, November 7, 1980, he guided the world-wide extension of the Legion with heroic dedication.

The unit of the Legion of Mary is called a presidium, our parish has two presidiums: 1) Our Lady of visitation (English) & 2) Our Lady of good council (Tamil).

We hold a weekly meeting, where prayer is intermingled with reports and discussion. At OLVC we hold the meeting every Monday at 7:30pm. Ordinary, simple people with whom you would not associate the idea of very great accomplishment showing a degree of spirit which seemed to be limitless. Mary is so much part of God's idea that without her we do not grasp His idea. She is, as the church sings, at the beginning of God's way with us. And she accompanies us every step of that way. The Heavenly Father placed her side by side with His Son in the plan of Redemption.

Incarnation reaches its climax in the Act of Redemption, and it finds Mary at the foot of the Cross, offering up her Divine Son on behalf of the redeemed human race, and in her role on Calvary she merited the right to dispense all graces purchased by the sacrifice of her Son.

The Legion sees as its priority the spiritual

and social welfare of each individual. Every legionary is required to carry out a weekly apostolic work in the spirit of faith and in union with Mary. The Legion must, as a first principle, set out to establish a contact of some sort with every soul everywhere. The members participate in the life of the parish through visitation of families, Prison cell, Sick, both in their homes and in hospitals. Every year on 11th Feb, Feast of our Lady of Lourdes, OLVC celebrates mass for the sick and home bound. Legionaries with faith and courage, make arrangements for the desired sick to attend the mass. Our commitment, even during this pandemic continued, from June we collaborated enquiring and praying for the health and wellbeing of the parishioners, by means of messages and mobile calls. There are certain other parochial works for senior legionaries such as Altar Society work, Mass serving, etc.

Seeing and serving Christ in the sick and marginalised is another vital part of the legionary apostolate. While not engaging in the giving of material relief, legionaries will often find opportunities to do works of service for the needy.

Today the Legion is organized in nearly all the dioceses throughout the world. The purpose of this association of Catholics is to make its members better Catholics and to raise the spiritual level of the entire community through direct contact with and interest in every member and potential member of the Mystical Body of Christ.

Currently between active and auxiliary members there are over 10 million members worldwide making it the largest apostolic organization of lay people in the Catholic Church, in over 160 countries.

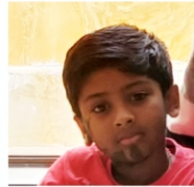

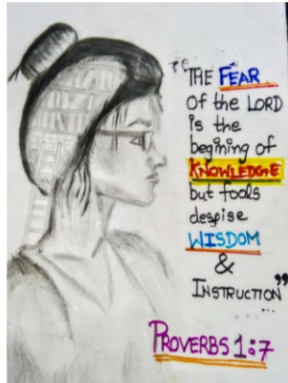
